

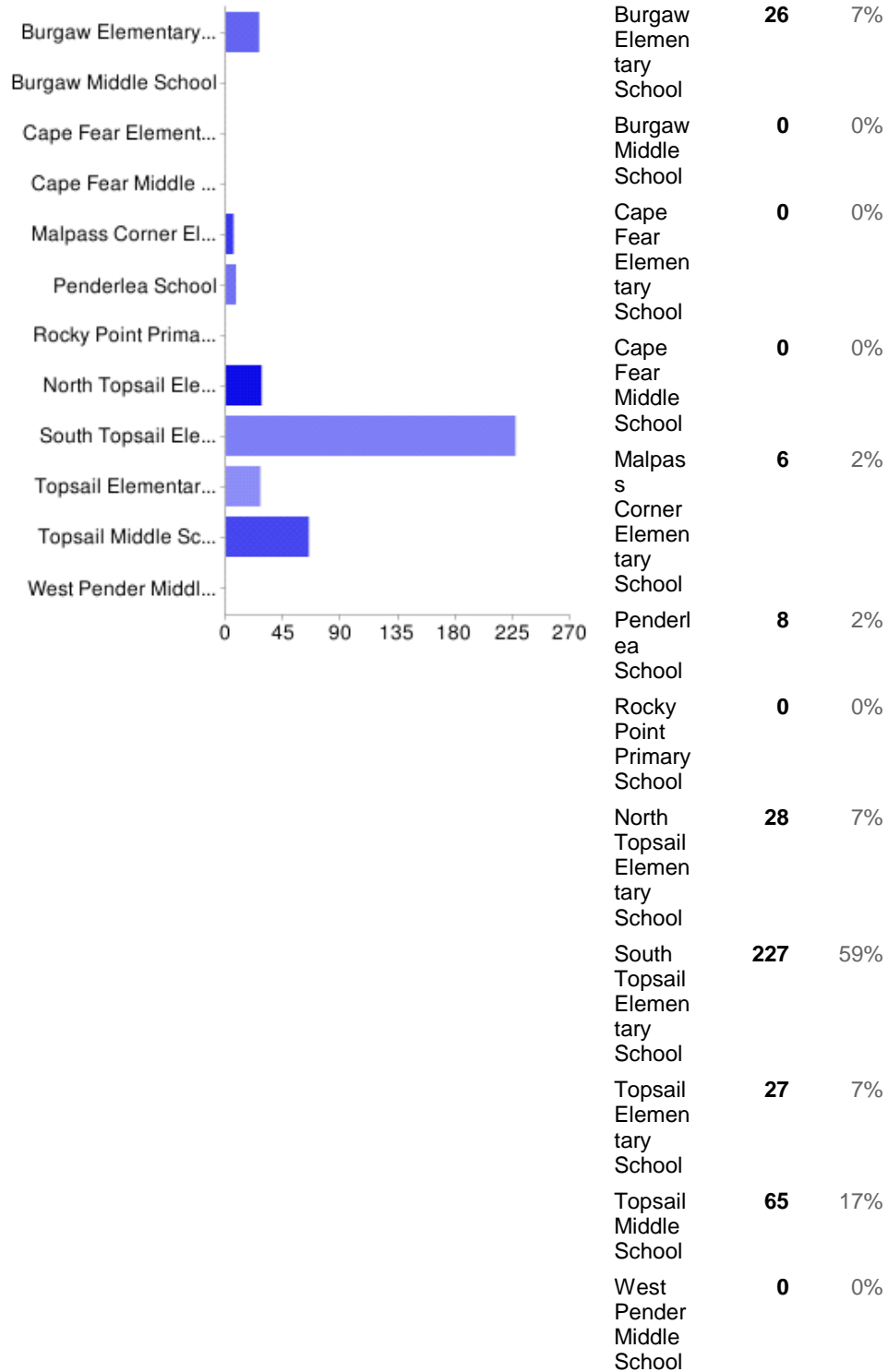

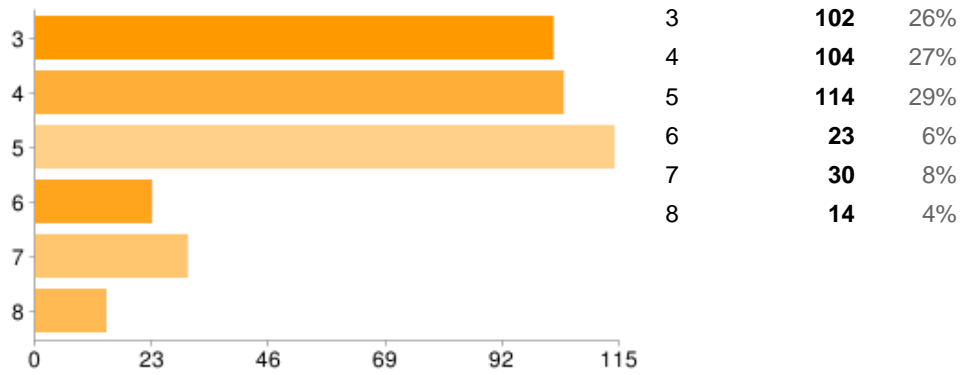

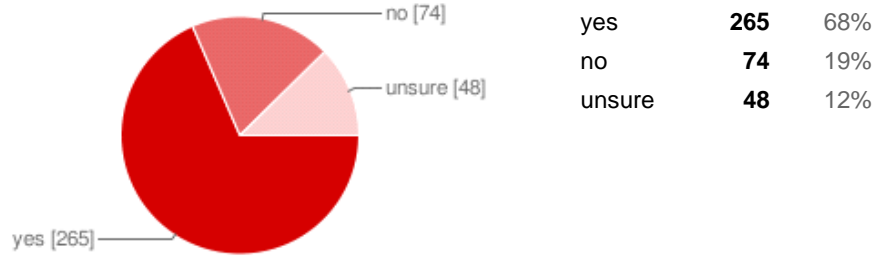
What school do you attend?



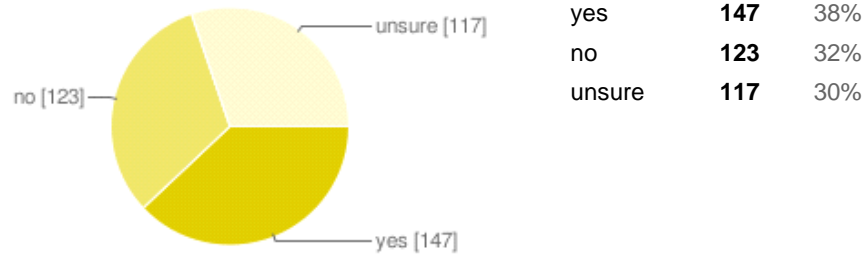
What grade are you in this year?



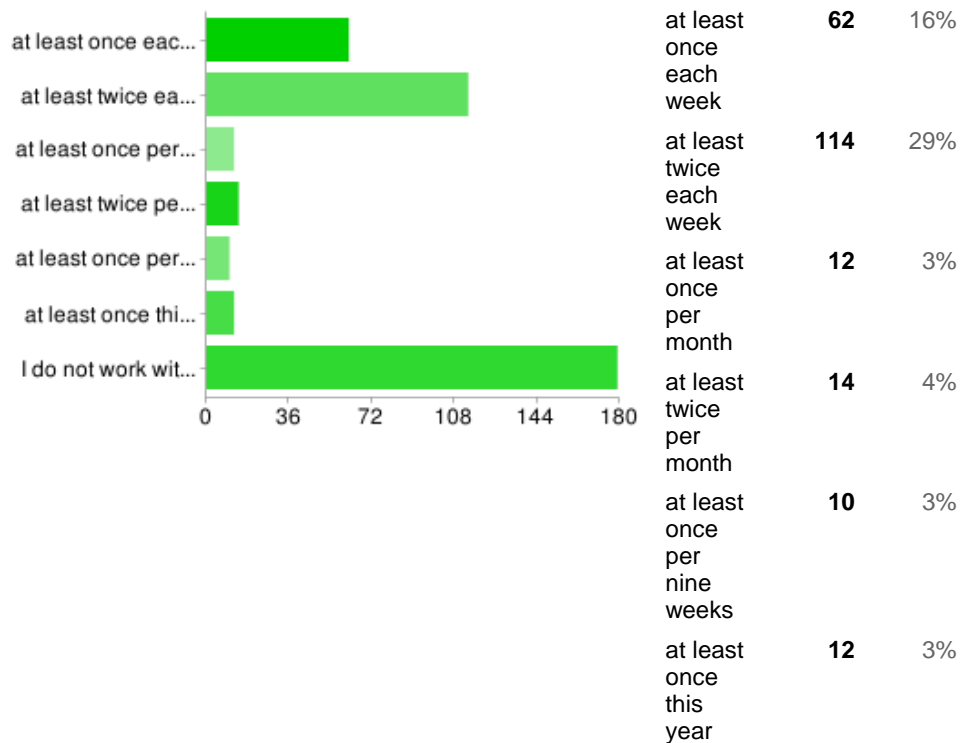
Do you know who the AIG Specialist for your school is?

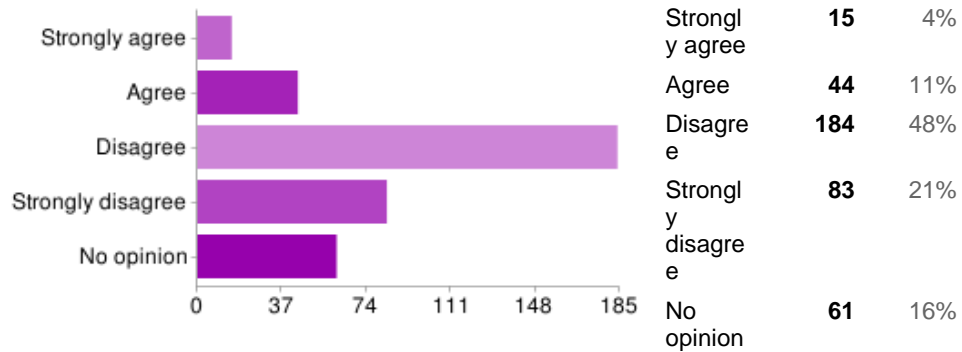

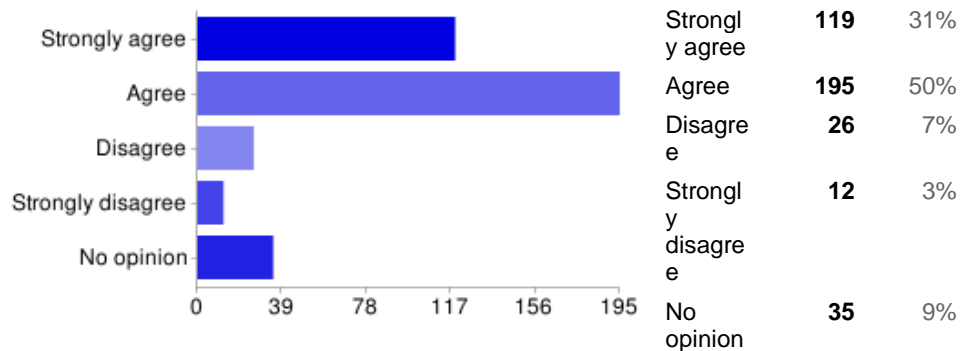

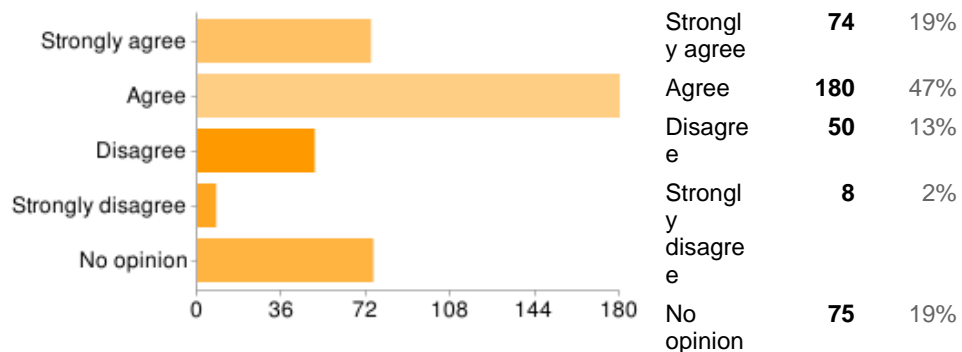
Rate how strongly you agree or disagree with each statement: - I feel I am given more work than other people in my class.



Rate how strongly you agree or disagree with each statement: - I have opportunities to learn about things that interest me.

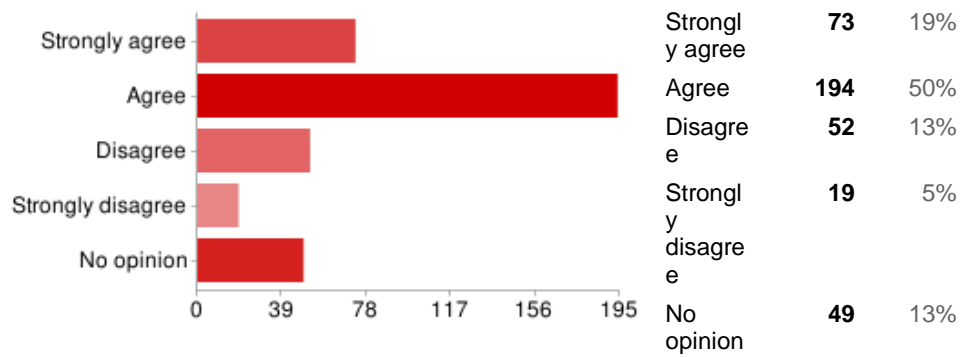


Rate how strongly you agree or disagree with each statement: - I have time in school to learn about topics in greater depth.

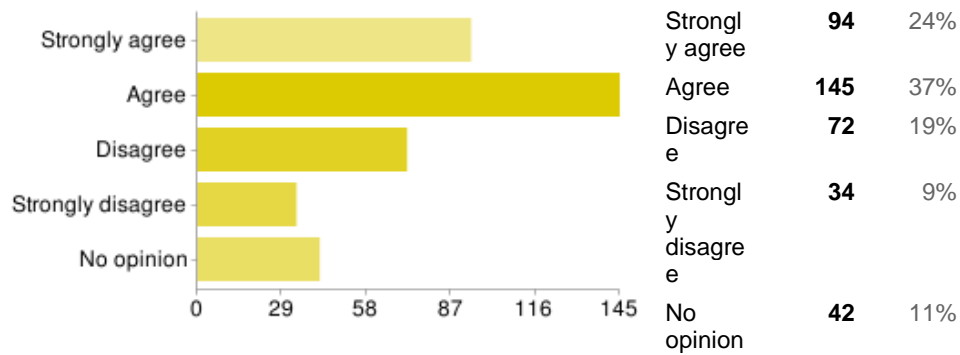


Rate how strongly you agree or disagree with each statement: - It is okay if people know there are topics

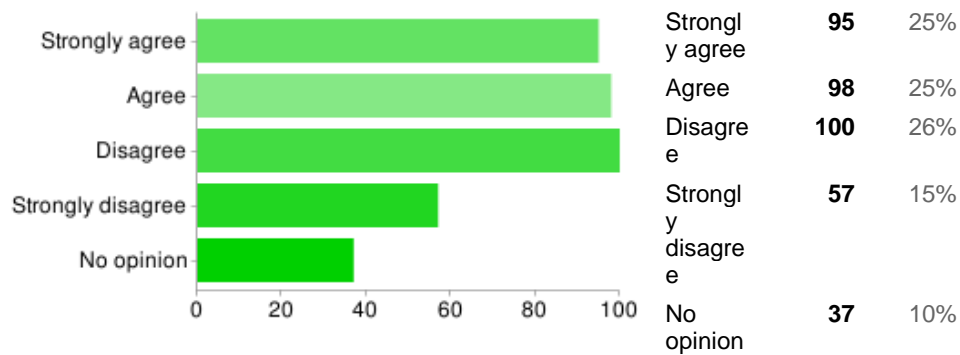

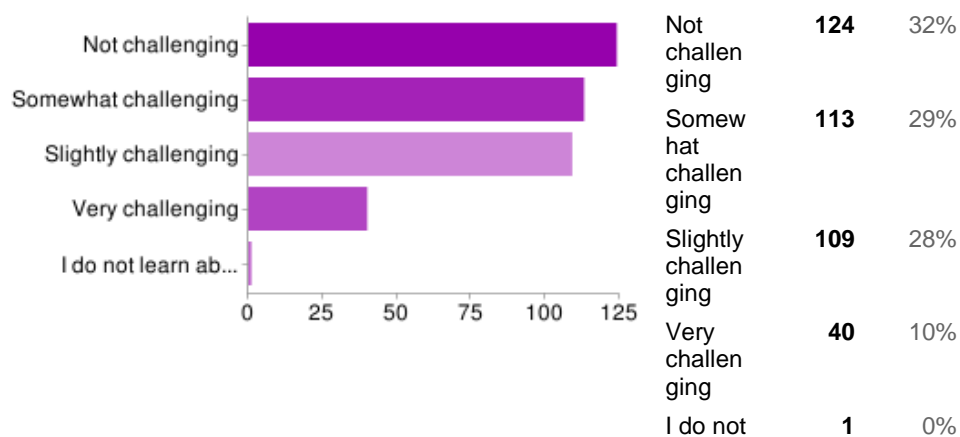
Rate how strongly you agree or disagree with each statement: - I realize all students have strengths in different areas, and I do not have to succeed in all areas.



Rate how strongly you agree or disagree with each statement: - I believe grades show how smart a student is.

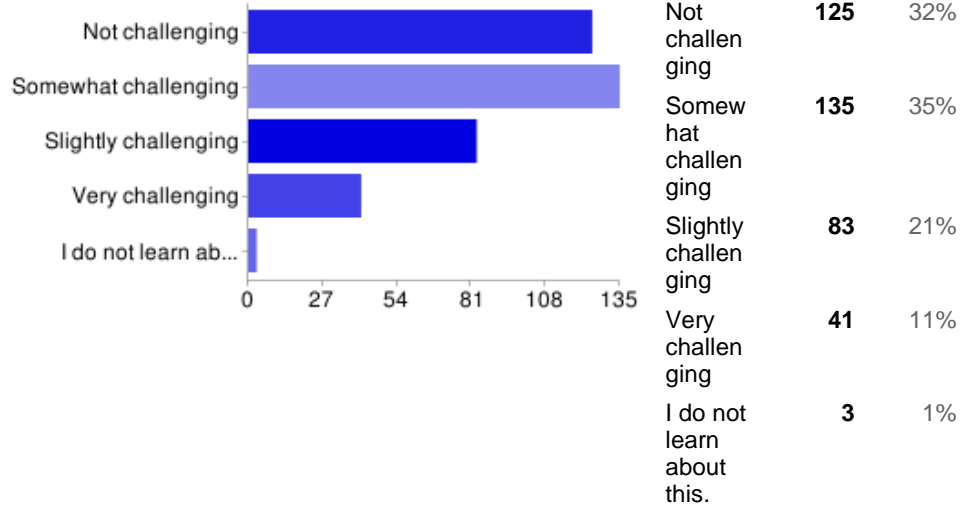

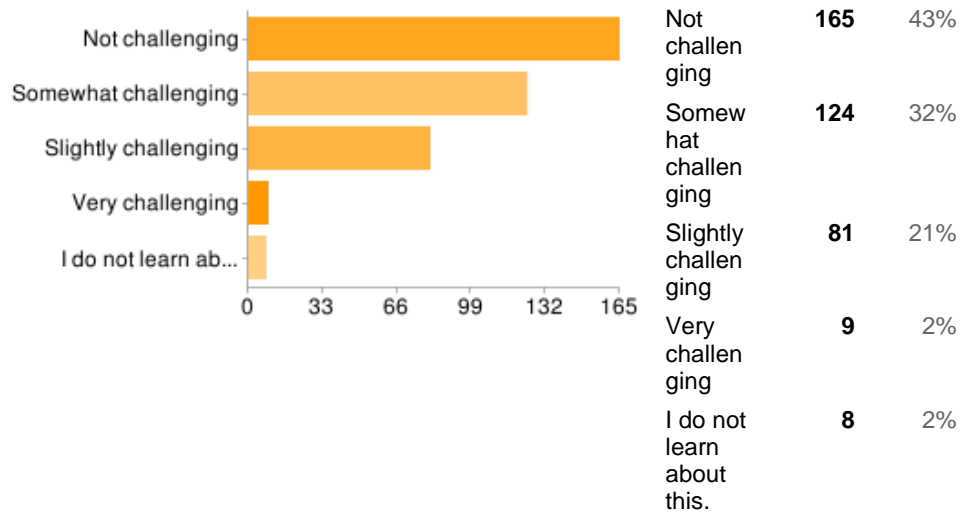
